

Day 1 – Sunday 26 April 2020
Arrive Darwin

Day 2 – Monday 27 April 2020
Darwin

Today we'll discover the beautiful city of Darwin in half a day. See the historic sites of **East Point Military Precinct, Mooring Basin, Stokes Hill Wharf** – the site of Darwin's bombing – and the Museum and Art Gallery. We'll also visit the Chinese Temple and stroll through the Botanic Gardens and then gain some insight into Australia's WWII history and Darwin's bombing. See the city's historic sites, including the East Point Military Precinct, Mooring Basin and the Stokes Hill Wharf area.

This evening we'll take a **sunset cruise** where the best views of Darwin's famous sunset are experienced. This 2.5 hour cruise includes a great commentary on the harbour and Darwin's great history and dinner onboard.

Day 3 – Tuesday 28 April 2020
Katherine

Today, we'll travel to **Katherine**, the third largest town in the Northern Territory, and often described as the place where the outback meets the tropics. En-route to the renowned waterfalls of **Litchfield National Park** today, we'll stop to explore a stand of architectural, two metre tall termite mounds. At **Florence Falls**, we'll view the beautiful waterhole from a high vantage point before venturing further to tropical **Wangi Falls** for an unforgettable swim in the large crystal-clear pool surrounded by spectacular monsoon rainforest. Later, we'll travel on to Katherine and dinner tonight will be at our hotel.

Day 4 – Wednesday 29 April 2020
Katherine Gorge

Today there is the opportunity to purchase some local Indigenous art. Later, sit back and relax in tranquil surroundings as you cruise on **Katherine Gorge**. Stunning rock faces will tower over you as we discover the history and culture of the Jawoyn people, traditional owners of **Nitmiluk**.



Day 5 – Thursday 30 April 2020
Katherine to Kakadu

This morning stop at **Edith Falls** where there's an opportunity for a swim. We'll then pass through the mining town of Pine Creek, whose buildings date back to the heady goldrush days. Travel deep into World Heritage listed Kakadu National Park and discover its spectacular escarpment, serene waterholes and teeming wildlife. Board the famed **Yellow Water Billabong Cruise**, spotting basking crocodiles and abundant birdlife with a local guide. Later, view spectacular **Aboriginal rock art** at **Nourlangie**.

Day 6 – Friday 01 May 2020
Kakadu

B - D

Today we'll visit **Ubirr** to view astounding **Aboriginal rock art** dating back some 20,000 years. Take the short climb to the top of this rocky outcrop for superb views over the floodplains and endless escarpment country. Enjoy the **Guluyambi Cultural Cruise**, a unique boat tour on Kakadu's scenically spectacular East Alligator River. Take in the wonderful pristine wilderness of this World Heritage landscape as you leisurely cruise upstream. An aboriginal guide provide us with an insight into their culture, local mythology, the river's abundant food chain, traditional uses for many plants and animals as well as bush survival skills.

Day 7 – Saturday 02 May 2020
Kakadu – Darwin/Depart Darwin

This morning we'll leave Kakadu to return to Darwin. Keep an eye on those river crossings to see if you can spot saltwater crocodiles. Our final stop is **Fogg Dam**, a birdwatcher's paradise. Bid farewell to your fellow travellers as our holiday comes to an end and we are transferred to Darwin Airport for our onward flight.
